SMART PHONES - AGREE TO AGREE

Knocknagree N.S. is part of a pilot scheme with other schools in Kerry again this year. Dr. Maureen Griffin guided school communities last year through a collaborative process which aimed at implementing positive change, fostering agreement and understanding among school stakeholders in order to establish a new norm for children's use of internet enabled devices. There will be an event held on Thursday 25^{th} September in the hall in Rathmore at 7pm, where the schools involved in the pilot will launch their agreements. All parents are welcome to attend this event. Dr. Maureen Griffin who is a forensic psychologist, will speak on the night about the negative effect phones and social media are having on our children and identify the dangers that are out there.

PUPIL PERSONAL ACCIDENT

This year the pupil personal accident insurance is part of the photocopying/arts & crafts contribution which all families pay at the beginning of the school year.

DROP OFF AND COLLECTION ROUTINES

School begins at 9.15am. We ask that children are dropped off **no sooner than 9.05am**. School finishes at **2.55pm (1.55pm for Junior and Senior Infants)**. The school authority will not be responsible for the children on the school grounds outside of these times. Children are not allowed to leave the school grounds unless an adult is there to collect them.

IF A CHILD IS SICK

It is imperative that parents do not send children to school if they are showing symptoms of any illness whatsoever. Any child who is sick will have to be sent home immediately as there are still regular positive cases of Covid-19 in the community. UNIFORM

Our normal crested half zip is required. Plain navy unbranded tracksuit / shorts and a blue polo shirt. Children can occasionally mislay their zip tops and jackets during the school day. Please ensure that zip tops and jackets are marked with child's name.

ATTENDANCE

If your child has to leave school for part of the day, please update the school on the Aladdin app informing the class teacher of his/her absence. Children must be signed out by whoever is collecting them, if they leave for part of the day they must be signed back in when they return. All absences must be accounted for. Now and then parents will be asked to reply to a notification on Aladdin Connect, please reply promptly.

HEALTHY LUNCHES AND FOOD ALLERGIES

We encourage a healthy lunch. Chewing gum, fizzy drinks, chocolate, sweets and crisps are not allowed. We have pupils in the school with nut allergies. It is very important that pupils do not bring items to school that contain nuts. We ask parents and children to be vigilant as some products contain traces of nuts.
