# **Drop Off and Collection Routines**

Children are not allowed to leave the school grounds unless an adult is there to collect them.

## Parent Contact

Any child who is sick will have to be sent home immediately as there are still regular positive cases of Covid-19 in the community. It is vital that parents/guardians are contactable at all times throughout the school day in case of children becoming ill.

# E-Payment System/Aladdin Connect

The e-payment system is up and running. We thank all parents who have paid for Photocopying Arts/Crafts so far this year. We have started using Aladdin Connect for sending notes home and parents adding absences of their children. Recently, a permission form was sent on connect, any parent who has not yet replied please do so as soon as possible.

# <u>Uniform</u>

Our normal school crested jumper is required. Plain navy unbranded tracksuit / shorts and a blue polo shirt. Children can occasionally mislay their jumpers, cardigans and jackets during the school day. Please ensure that jumpers, cardigans and jackets are marked with child's name.

#### Attendance

If your child has to leave school for part of the day, please update the school on the app informing the class teacher of his/her absence. Children must be signed out by whoever is collecting them, if they leave for part of the day they must be signed back in when they return. All absences must be accounted for.

## Healthy Lunches and Food Allergies

We encourage a healthy lunch. Chewing gum, fizzy drinks, chocolate, sweets and crisps, are not allowed. We have pupils in the school with nut allergies. It is very important that pupils do not bring items to school that contain nuts. We ask parents and children to be vigilant as some products contain traces of nuts. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

#### Initiatives
